What should I do / say?

- Please stop you are being mean
- Tell an adult
- Tell a friend
- Tell a play leader



Bullying

When someone says or does something purposefully hurtful and they **keep** doing it – even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset.

What does it look like?



- Name calling,
- Teasing,
- Pushing,
- Hitting,
- Kicking,
- Threatening,
- Spreading rumours,
- Starting an argument,
- Leaving people out on purpose.
- It can be on a computer, in a text, or any sort of online space.

What should I do / say?

- **You need to tell an adult**

You can also:

- Walk away
- Tell a play leader



An adult will report the incident using the report format.

Children, parents, and staff will work together to mend the friendship using our policy.

We will continue to check up on you to make sure you feel happy and safe.

What TO DO When YOU see BULLYING:



- **Don't** laugh, watch or join in with the bully
 - **Do** tell an adult
- **Do** be a friend to the child who is being bullied
- **Do** tell the bully to stop and say you don't like bullying
