Literacy – Description of the bear.

Task 1:

Before the boy sees the bear, he hears movement and sees a figure in the darkness. Think of ways you can 'hear' and 'see' the bear before it appears and how the boy is feeling. I've added examples to help you.



Hear	See	The boy's feelings
Rustling	A large, dark figure	terrified

Use your ideas above to write a couple of sentences about this moment in the book. Remember you are writing from the boy's point of view.

Example:

At that moment, a large figure shifted in the corner of my eye and I heard an unusual rustling sound. My heart began to thump rapidly.

Task 2:

When the bear appears into the light, we need to be able to describe him. Create a mind map for how the bear looks and moves. This can include: adjectives, verbs and adverbs (you might even want to add expanded noun phrases).



Again, practise writing these into full sentences of when the boy sees the bear.

Example:

Furiously, the bear whipped its gigantic paw with sharp claws and I quickly threw myself out of the way.
