



Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs


Home Learning Challenge



Read a non-fiction book about dinosaurs, or research on the Internet. Write down 3 facts you find out about dinosaurs, that you didn't know before.




'Carry' rhymes with 'Harry'. Can you think of some more words that rhyme with 'Harry'? They can be real or nonsense words. Try to write a list of 6.




Play some music and dance like a dinosaur. You could ask your family or friends to join in. Make some dinosaur roars whilst you stomp around the room.

If there are 10 dinosaurs in the swamp and 3 get lost, how many are left? Use your fingers to help you.



As the dinosaurs grow, they might not fit inside Harry's bucket anymore. Can you make a new container for Harry to carry the dinosaurs in? You could use boxes and bottles from the recycling.



Design and draw a new dinosaur. Think about whether it will have a long or short neck, spikes, scales or feathers and what its tail will look like. Can you create a name for your new dinosaur?
