I'd like to start by giving my thanks to families for such a positive response to my appeals, last week. We very much appreciate your cooperation and engagement with us. And it is 2-way: I have made changes to our school sports clubs in response to a request from families and Mr Gunstone's Clubs are very popular, this half term.

After half term, we will be looking to incorporate more non-sports clubs for after school and lunchtimes. PUPIL VOICE is very important to us and I have asked the Values team to ask classes what they would like. So far: computers, nature and choir are popular. As I have stressed before, clubs are dependent on staff being able to fit it into their own work/life balance and they do this for free. Lots of local schools have clubs that are costed, but we will try and find a balance. Choir will return after half term! Mrs Moore and I will run it at a lunchtime suited to the class.

More families are also using the drop-off system in the car park, **but there is still capacity for more families using it**. It is open 8:40 – 8:59am and is much easier than trying to find a spot down the muddy lane and walking up!
