### School News Mr Gillan

- LUNCHES: Our menus are coming home, today. We have, only recently, been notified by our suppliers that they will not be providing packed lunches from January onwards. This news means that **Key Stage 2 will need to bring their own packed lunch after Christmas**. However, the good news is that we are in a position to begin a rollout of hot lunches, over a period of time, to the rest of the school. This starts with Year 3 from January. Year 3 pupils will bring home menus **today**. Further year groups will be notified in due course. We need to see what challenges occur by introducing additional year groups to the meal plan and timings, whilst keeping everyone in discrete bubbles.
- Since 2016, we have maintained the same charges for our Breakfast and After School Clubs. Due to the increasing pressures of food price increases and resources, from January onwards, we have taken the decision to increase the price of After School Club by 50p per hour. This brings it in line with Breakfast Club. The good news is that we will be extending our Monday Thursday hours up to 5pm, as we now have substantial cover for our vital, increased cleaning duties that need to be carried out throughout the school day. Our online system has been set up by Mrs Carter and is ready to take bookings for term 2.
