September Review

Mr Gillan

With October already here, it is worth looking back at a very successful September at Thurlbear:

- 97.1% attendance for the whole school;
- 99.2% punctuality for the 9am registration;
- Approximately 60% of Key Stage 2 attended Mr Gunstone's After-School Sports clubs!
- **146** pupils have 100% attendance for the month (very good considering the various bugs going through the school).
- **Numbers** are growing in Key Stage 2 for those choosing a hot lunch, once again (>50% having a hot lunch at least one day per week)
- 117 parents / carers are subscribed to our blog, meaning they get automatic email notification for every post, including the weekly newsletter.
- 2,100 brand new stickers have been ordered and are now in use ("I received this sticker please ask me why") you may already have seen one on your child! We have designed it uniquely for Thurlbear pupils and want them to stimulate conversation between home and school.
