Please contact us if you are not sure or are a new family.
- Breakfast and After School provision is as popular as ever, if not more so, right now. Please do book this in advance or assume we will have space, as we have to monitor our pupil / staff ratios daily and this can be affected if pupils just turn up on the day.
- We do have cases of COVID throughout school year groups and now we have head lice. With head lice, please check your child over the weekend if possible.

As our COVID cases are throughout our age groups, please be vigilant with your child. Any symptoms, you must seek a PCR and isolate until the results come back (Public health Somerset advice-line guidelines). In Oak Class, pupils are offered a PCR even if they are feeling well, which is not the case, usually. This helps pick up any asymptomatic cases.

## Safeguarding Mr Gillan

As a practical solution to some of the COVID issues that we have all faced, families have devised effective drop-off and pick-up systems with friends or neighbors over the past 2 years.
