At the end of the last school year, our Values Team met with Mrs Hetherington-

Prissell – parent governor – to discuss ways in which we could improve the school from the point of view of our pupils. Our VT is a collection of pupils ranging from Year 2 to 6 – voted in by their peers – and tasked with ideas based on our 5 Christian values (see below!). One main request was the return **READING BUDDIES!**

"What is a reading buddy?" older year groups 'buddy-up' with younger pupils and both read **to** them as well as read **with** them. They share a love of a book, as well as learning names and personalities! Here, you can see Year 5 have buddies up with Year 1! Over the year, the relationship and bonds grow between the classes and memories are made. It deepens the reading experience and promotes a sense

This week, their officer came in to work on a mapping session and our pupils had a brilliant time learning about our locality using aerial photographs and OS maps.
