### Around School Mr Gillan

As we start a new term, it is a good time to revisit some fundamental aspects of school life.

Breakfast and After School Clubs: Both of these are always on offer and can be booked via the Pay360 system. When there are online issues, we try and comminute as quickly as possible with families and we manually book in the pupils. Please ensure that you book your child in. Every day, we print off our list which is generated from the system and we have details of when every child plans to leave (either 4:30 or 5:15pm, depending on what has been booked). This means it becomes hard to manage numbers if there are regular pupils coming into ASC without a prior booking and can affect our important staff-to-pupil ratios. We fully appreciate there are times when you have to ring us and need a last-minute space, but this has been ever-increasing and we need to get back to bookings in advance.

• **Uniform:** the vast majority of the day-to-day uniform worn by our pupils is exactly what it should be. In Term 1, there was some variation in clothing worn during PE and Sports sessions. We ask for:

Plain, white t-shirts without large logos;

Dark shorts minimal logo;

Leggings and jogging bottoms, if needed, should be dark and plain; Trainers can be worn in outdoor sessions, but be mindful that they will get dirty very quickly, so that's a caveat for brand-new trainers;

**Hoodies** should be worn for games and outdoor activities only; jumpers and cardigans should be the normal wear around school.

**We have pre-loved uniform** in abundance and we love distributing it. Please ask us about it!
