

### Wednesday Topic Activity- Stone Age Timeline.

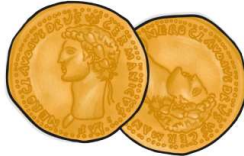

**100BC**



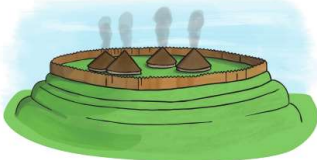
Coins are made and used for the first time.

**1,800BC**



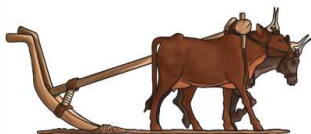
The first copper mines are dug.
